Magna Carta (1215)

Limited Government

beginning of rule of law

for the first time, the king had to follow a law

English Bill of Rights (1689)

Parliament is more powerful than the king certain rights guaranteed for the people

Mayflower Compact (1620)

first self-government in America

direct democracy

for a small colony of about 100 population

Common Sense (1776)

written by Thomas Paine

became a sensational best seller

Convinced many people to support the revolution
