Identify how the weaknesses of the Articles of Confederation led to the writing of the Constitution.

1781: Articles of Confederation = first Constitution for the USA
it was a "League of Friendship" between the states
Each state had one vote in the Confederation Congress
but it was difficult to get anything done
required nine of the 13 votes to pass any law required all 13 to amend the articles (never happened)
Federal (national) Government was very weak
no power to levy taxes
no power to enforce laws
legislative branch only - no executive, no judicial
States could tax each other
Each state printed its own money
Shay's Rebellion demonstrated the problems
1787 - Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia
12 of the 13 states participated (Rhode Island did not) Intended to suggest revisions to the Articles of Confederation

The delegates quickly decided to write a whole new
Constitution instead
