Influences on the US legal system

- ➤ #1 influence: Common Law of England (Court rulings & tradition over several centuries)
- > Roman Law
- ➤ Napoleonic Code (French legal system, very important in Louisiana)

Sources of Law

- > US Constitution
- > State constitutions
- > Statutes (laws passed by Congress & state legislatures)
- > Case law (court decisions that tell us how to interpret laws)
- ➤ Administrative law(regulations from executive branch agencies)

Types of law

- > Criminal Law
 - o Felonies serious crimes
 - Misdemeanors minor crimes
- ➤ Civil Law (disputes) four branches:
 - o Contract law agreements
 - Property law buying & selling property; rights of owners and renters
 - o Family law marriage, divorce, adoptions, child custody, etc.
 - Personal Injury law torts
 - Can be intentional (serious) or negligent (less serious)
- ➤ Military Law separate laws that apply to service members
