SS.7.C.3.5 Explain the Constitutional amendment process.

It's a two-step process:

1-Proposed Amendment passes Congress

two-thirds vote required in the House and also in the Senate

2-The states then vote to approve or reject it

requires three-fourths of the states to ratify the Amendment

Alternative way to start an Amendment

If two-thirds of the states ask for it, we would have a new Constitutional Convention *(for the first time since* 1787)

this could get an Amendment started without going through Congress

this option has never been used Whatever comes from the new Constitutional Convention would still need to be approved by three-fourths of the states
