**#1 Goal - don't feed the dinosaur!** (a.k.a. prevent tyranny) **How the Constitution keeps government power under control: Federalism** 

many powers are "reserved" for the states only

## **Separation of Powers**

government power is split three ways (thank you, Mr. Montesquieu!)

Legislative branch - makes laws Executive Branch - carries out (executes) the laws Judicial Branch - interprets laws

## **Checks & Balances**

each branch has the ability to pull back against the other two

a never-ending three-way tug of war to keep any branch from getting too far off course
